Rules

1. Open to any four lady curlers
2. Played using Schenkel system.
3. Two points will be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw with ENDS then SHOTS UP then SHOTS SCORED
4. All games shall be 8 ENDS or TIME OF TWO HOURS, (the bell will be rung at One Hour Fifty Minutes) whichever is the earlier, The final will be the same.
5. Times of play cannot be changed.
7. The top two teams in table will play in the Final at 3.15pm on Thursday 19th January. Prizes will be awarded to Winners and Runners Up.
8. Ice Charges - £15.00 per person per daytime session and £18.00 per person per evening session.
9. Skips are advised to check playing times with their rinks as skips are responsible for collecting and paying of ice fees. It is also the skips' responsibility to hand to the Ice Master a fully completed score card after each game. An incomplete score card will result in elimination from the competition.
10. A substitute cannot play any higher than the person they replace. Two substitutes may be used per game, but three may be used throughout the competition with agreement with the Competitions and Selections Committee. A substitute can play for more than one rink.
11. The RCCC rules for the Royal Club Competitions will apply except as altered above or by any Special rule laid down by the Competitions and Selections Committee.
12. Any dispute will be settled by the Lockerbie Ladies Committee whose decision will be final.
13. The three player rule will be in use as per RCCC rules
